The **Michigan Fire Instructor-I** program's goal is to create "*superior fire instructors*" statewide. The program utilized the NFPA 1041 Standard for Fire and Emergency Services Instructor Professional Qualifications as its guide. All sections of this program comply with NFPA 1041.

This is a five (5) day course. Attendance at each class session is mandatory. Each class session is eight (8) hours; a large amount of information will be missed by an absence and can't be made up. Prior to the first day of class, you are required to read Chapters 1-8 in the Jones and Bartlett, Fire and Emergency Services Instructor, Principles and Practices 3rd Edition.

- Must be a member, or have been a member, within the last five (5) years of an organized Michigan fire department.
- Must possess Fire Fighter I and II certification.
- Must have a minimum of three (3) years firefighting experience at the time of application and be certified at the level/course they wish to instruct. (Minimum Fire Fighter II or at least one (1) of the wild land specialty/subject matter expert courses).

Cost – \$300 per student (Fireworks funding can be used for this course – Contact course manager)

Students must purchase Jones and Bartlett Fire and Emergency Services Instructor Principles and Practices, 3rd Edition.
