

NFPA 1041 FIRE Instructor II Spring 2025

NFPA 1041 Instructor II (H08B) This NFPA 1041 Fire Instructor II course minimally meets all objectives and JPRs in the 2019 edition of NFPA 1041. The textbook used for the current NFPA 1041 Fire Instructor II course is the Jones & Bartlett Fire and Emergency Services Instructor 3rd Edition and instructors, and students will use the J&B Navigate online learning platform during the seven (7) session course. The course consists of five (5) in person or virtual sessions and two (2) in person sessions. The written exam will be held during session 6 and the practical will be session 7. Student preparation and homework completion is required prior to the online session of class. The course is limited to 16 students per course.

Student Prerequisites:

- Eighteen years of age or older.
- Member of an organized Michigan Fire Department.
- Member of an organized Michigan Fire Department for 5 years from initial certification.
- Must be certified at the fire fighter II level.
- Must be able to use Microsoft Word and Microsoft PowerPoint
- Must be Certified Fire Instructor I (O54A or O54B).
- Must have 40 hours of documented and verifiable instructional time.

This course is SMOKE funded. Participant's fire departments must be NFIRS reporting compliant or pay course fee of \$200.
